

## Entrust Your Future To God

1 Samuel 24

### When We Entrust our Future to God:

**1 Samuel 24:1-2** <sup>1</sup>After Saul returned from pursuing the Philistines, he was told, "David is in the Desert of En Gedi." <sup>2</sup>So Saul took three thousand chosen men from all Israel and set out to look for David and his men near the Crag of the Wild Goats.

**1 Samuel 24:5-7** <sup>5</sup>Afterward, David was conscience-stricken for having cut off a corner of his robe. <sup>6</sup>He said to his men, "The LORD forbid that I should do such a thing to my master, the LORD's anointed, or lift my hand against him; for he is the anointed of the LORD." <sup>7</sup>With these words David rebuked his men and did not allow them to attack Saul. And Saul left the cave and went his way.

#### 1. We do what is right regardless of the cost.

**1 Samuel 24:11-12** <sup>11</sup>See, my father, look at this piece of your robe in my hand! I cut off the corner of your robe but did not kill you. Now understand and recognize that I am not guilty of wrongdoing or rebellion. I have not wronged you, but you are hunting me down to take my life. <sup>12</sup>May the LORD judge between you and me. And may the LORD avenge the wrongs you have done to me, but my hand will not touch you.

#### 2. We leave the results to God.
