

Full Re-entry Plan for Peak Kids:



Currently the PEAK is opening Nursery – 5th Grade on Sunday's at 10:30am with classroom attendance caps and CDC guidance.

To ensure child and volunteer safety we are following guidelines set by our current FIC Insurance Company, the CDC and County Health pertaining to Childcare Specific Federal Guidelines. We will have a max of 8 nursery children, 10 preschool children and 25 Elementary aged children at each service. Check in will begin at 10:15am. Temperatures for children will be taken at check in. As stated by the CDC we are making sure that child temps are under 100.4 degrees. Peak kids under 10 years old are not required to wear a mask but encouraged to. As stated by the CDC masks are not required and should not be worn by children 2 years or older. If your child is over 10 years old masks are required. All Peak staff are required to wear masks, wash hands often and have their temp take to ensure your child's safety.

We are asking that Peak parents please register their children the week before service by Friday's. This enables us to create a safe and fun environment for your children! All Peak classrooms are sanitized 30 min before classes begin with a touchless sanitizing system.

Check In:

- 1 Parent/Guardian will need to drop off children, we are asking that only 1 parent drop off to limit the amount of people in the Peak Kids area.
- Peak kids will be dropped off at the entrance to the preschool room or either entrance to wing hallways. Parents/guardians will not be permitted in the classrooms.
- At check in, Peak kids will receive their pre-printed name tag and have their temperature taken (Making sure temp is under 100.4 for children.). Parents may choose to use hand sanitizer or go and wash their child's hands with soap and water before class.
- If you would like your child to wear a mask throughout the entirety of our class but your kiddo might have a little trouble keeping it on; help can be offered to your child. Parents can request a Peak wrist band for their child that alerts Peak staff to help keep your child mask in place. Peak staff will not hold your child's mask if taken off during service.
- If at any time your child is having trouble in class or begin to not feel well parents will be called using call numbers on their claim tag which will be posted on the sanctuary screens.

In Class Nursery

- Due to child and staff safety, diaper changes and feeding will not be conducted in the nursery at this time.
- Diaper bags will not be held in the nursery.
- Nursery Staff will maintain proper hygiene and wash hands between each child interaction.
- "Yuck buckets" will be used for toys that are put in mouths and then placed on the floor.
- If your child needs changed or fed parents will be called with their call number on the sanctuary screens.

In Class (Preschool & Elementary):

- Masks are encouraged but not required for kids under 10. All of our staff and volunteers are required to wear masks. If you would like our staff and volunteers to help your child with keeping on their masks for the entire service, please communicate that at check in so that we can give them a wristband.
- No outside food or drink are allowed in the classrooms at this time.

Check Out:

- 1 parent/guardian (preferably the same parent that did drop off) for pick up and bring the claim tag.
- Hand sanitizing or hand washing is encouraged after class is over. Hand sanitizer will be provided upon exit but may be refused. Parents will be responsible for hand washing.
- Please pick up child immediately following service so we can sanitize our classrooms.
