

Wednesday Night Programs Re-Entry Plan for Peak Kids:



Currently the PEAK is opening Wednesday Night Programs GEMS & Cadets 1st – 5th Grade with classroom attendance caps and CDC guidance.

To ensure child and volunteer safety we are following guidelines set by our current FIC Insurance Company, the CDC and County Health pertaining to Childcare specific Federal guidelines. Check in will begin at 6:15pm at the West Peak Entrance doors. Temperatures for children will be taken outside the building at check in. As stated by the CDC we are making sure that child temps are under 100.4 degrees. Students under 10 years old are not required to wear a mask but strongly encouraged to. If your child is over 10 years old masks are required.

If at any time your child begins to feel ill during programs parents will be called and children will be cared for in a separate classroom from their peers. We ask that if you receive a phone call from a Wednesday Night Programs staff member and your child is ill, that you pick up your child immediately.

All Peak Wednesday Night Programs staff members are required to wear masks through the entirety of programs, wash hands often and have their temperature taken before entering the building to ensure your child's safety.

All Wednesday Night Programs Kids, GEMS and Cadets must be registered online before the start of programs. This enables us to create a safe and fun environment for your children! Based on the number of registered children, grade-based cohorts will be created, and appropriate social distancing will take place. All Peak classrooms are sanitized 30 min before classes begin and immediately after classes have ended with a touchless sanitizing system.

Check In:

- Preferably only 1 Parent/Guardian will drop off their student/s at the Peak West Entrance outside doors. Parents/guardians will not be permitted in the building or in classrooms at this time.
- At the West entrance check in, students will have their temperature taken (Making sure temp is under 100.4 for children.) Kids will either use hand sanitizer or be asked to go to the bathrooms and wash their hands before entering the classroom.
- If your child is under 10 years old would like your child to wear a mask throughout the entirety of our class but your kiddo might have a little trouble keeping it on; help can be offered to your child. Parents can request a Peak wrist band child that alerts Peak Wednesday Night Programs staff to help keep your child mask in place. Peak staff will not hold your child's mask if taken off during class.
- If at any time your child is having trouble with class rules or begins to not feel well parents will be called for student pick up.

In Class:

- Masks are strongly encouraged but not required for kids under 10. We would suggest that your student should come to class with a mask on and we will instruct student when moving about the building to have their masks in place. All of our staff and volunteers are required to wear masks. If you would like our staff and volunteers to help your child with keeping on their masks in place for the entire class, please communicate that at check in so that we can give them a wristband for our teachers to identify them.
- No outside food or drink will be allowed in the classrooms at this time. Make sure your child has eaten dinner before coming to GEMS or Cadets.
- As students move about the building, masks are strongly encouraged to be in place. Students will move one cohort at a time as directed by our Wednesday Night Security Leader.

Check Out:

- Parents/guardians will please pull up to the West Peak Entrance of FIC and your student will be brought out to your car starting at 8:00pm. No parents or guardians are permitted inside the building for pick up at this time.

- Hand sanitizing or hand washing is encouraged after class is over. Hand sanitizer will be provided upon exit but may be refused.
- Please be ready to pick up your child at 8:0pm so we can sanitize our classrooms.
