



Discussion Prompts for 06/18/23

People of Humility – Philippians 2:1-5

An important note before you begin: These prompts are not meant to dictate what you discuss together. Instead, they're designed to inspire a free-flowing conversation. Never squelch the Holy Spirit by trying to get through all the questions. Read through a week's questions (there will be some weekly repeats) in advance and decide which ones might be best for your group, given their comfort level with each other.

Getting Started:

1. What do you remember from the sermon this past week?
2. How might your group describe the main idea of the message in just a couple of sentences?

Getting Specific:

1. In our text for this past Sunday (Philippians 2:1-5) PAul warns against the sort of disunity that can tear a church apart. What are some of the threats to disunity that exist
 - a. In your immediate family
 - b. In your extended Family
 - c. In your workplace
 - d. In your marriage

Going Deeper Together:

1. In the sermon, we looked very closely at the meaning of selfish ambition and conceit
 - a. Selfish ambition comes when we place our needs over the truth
 - b. Conciety comes when we are made to feel we don't matter
2. So there are two important questions to ask this week"
 - a. What apparent needs are so important to you that they dictate what you think is true?
 - b. In what areas does your self-importance feel threatened to the degree that you push back?

Going to Scripture:

1. In light of your personal reflections in the previous section (Going Deeper Together), how does the Gospel expressed in the following passages help you to “remedy” your “disease?” (Enjoy!)
 - a. Mark 10:45
 - b. Romans 5:8
 - c. Romans 6:23
 - d. Romans 8:32
 - e. 2 Corinthians 5:21
 - f. 2 Corinthians 8:9
 - g. 1 Timothy 1:15
 - h. 1 John 4:10
 - i. Revelations 5:9

Going Forward:

1. What have you discovered about life with God this week?
 2. How is this good for your neighbors, Westminster, or the world?
 3. In light of your discussion today, what are some implications for you or your group?
 4. How/when will you act on those implications (be careful not to skip these questions or take on too much)
